- Learner Education Handover (LEH)
- Learner Handover (LH)
 - The sharing of information about learners across educational phases and between faculty supervisors involved in their education

Pros

- Tailor educational experience for learners
- Support growth mindset in competency-based education

Cons

- Bias: Assimilation effect, esp. when cognitive load is high
- Stigmatization
- Stress for faculty members, learners

Interesting Information

- During 2021 – 2024, there were 4 experimental studies in medical education evaluating assimilation effect with learner handover
 - Two studies: No assimilation
 - Two studies: Assimilation

Take Home Messages

- In Competency-based Medical Education, individualized training is needed. So, learner handover might be a good thing to ensure learners' growth, and patient safety
- What should we do to maximize benefit
 - Learner handover => Learner Education Handover

Learner Education Handover

- Purpose: Continue improvement
- Learners have active role: ownership
- Standardization
- Rich information
- Programmatic assessment
- Integrated curriculum with longer block instead of short departmental rotations
- Entrustment decision: ad-hoc vs summative
 - Summative entrustment decision must be made by a team (clinical competency committee)
